The eighth Dasp Lunch Seminar focuses on the topic of Housing Research. Specific forms of dwelling will be presented by the four speakers, from the Japanese Danchi and Chinese home interiors to European alternative housing models and forms of social living in jail. Set in different geographical and cultural contexts, the heterogeneity of themes and goals of each thesis implies the observation of the case studies in precise transition moments, times of break from the past that produce innovation. Moreover the analysis introduces a variety of reference scales (from the single housing unit to the city) showing the possibilities that the housing research is able to open through opportune reading keys and a multidisciplinary approach – architectural, socio-political, psychological, legal and economic.
