The last lunch seminar of the year has as core subject four doctoral researches interrelated through the three terms stated in the symposium title: processes, projects, and politics. Recognizing in each work the presence of and the concern in the triad, the discussion arises from the comparison among its understanding in the researches in the attempt of accentuate the degrees of similarity and divergence that can be associated with the terms taken as reference. Therefore, the interpretation of the terms “project”, either as an architectural artifact or as a process, and “politics”, as governance or policy, constitutes a tensional relationship between the two axes taken as reference to position each research. The discussion will start through the presentation of the four doctoral researches, which will be followed by the positioning of each one according to the definitions assumed and a further debate extended to external guests.
